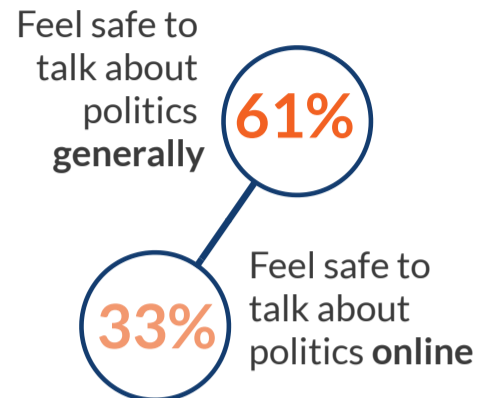
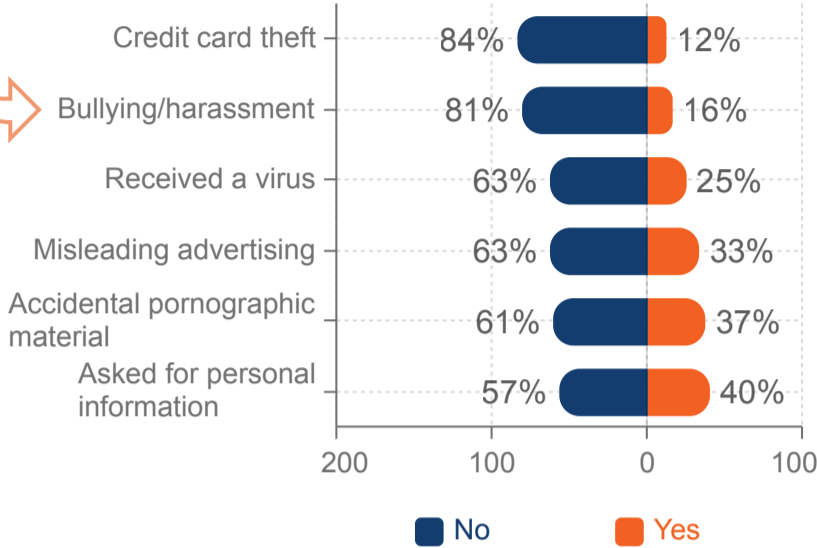


INTERNET USERS' OPINIONS IN NEW ZEALAND

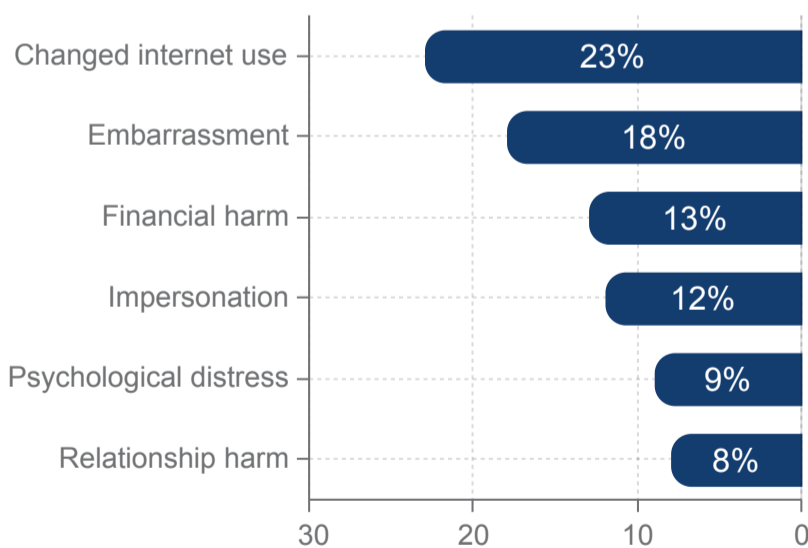
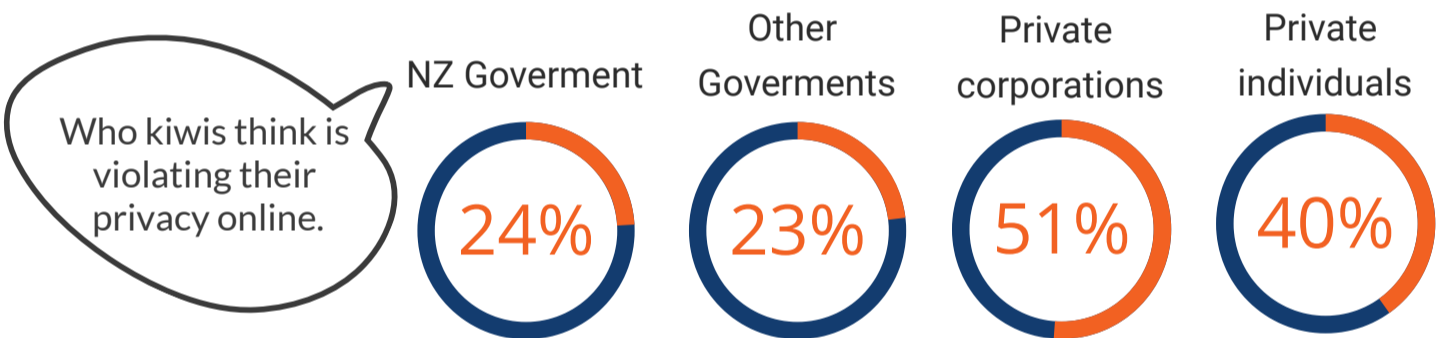

1/3 of these respondents were between 16 and 24 years old.

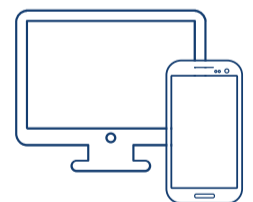
Negative experiences online



Almost **25%** of respondents believe that their privacy had been violated online in the past year.



Most common consequences of privacy violations



60% of respondents believe that social media companies like Facebook, TikTok & Twitter ought to be more strongly regulated than they are now,



30% believe that social media companies have made the world worse off.
